



Authority Control Backfile Processing

- **Updated**: author names, subject headings, genre headings, uniform titles, and series titles verified or updated to match the current Library of Congress headings.
- Alternative subject headings to records where the current authorized terms may seem outdated, insensitive, or confusing to our users.
- More inclusive terminology for describing groups of people using the words that these people often use to describe themselves
- Inclusion of Accelerated Reader and Lexile Measures
- Review our "near match" report to **improve search results**

- What's at stake? \$1 billion in funding to improve access to broadband internet, digital equity, and digital literacy.
- 140+ mentions of libraries in the final state plan!

Improved Connectivity Speeds in MHLS

30% increase in the number of libraries reporting improved connectivity speeds

Recommended: a minimum of **100 Mbps** for serving smaller communities and **1 Gbps** for libraries serving populations greater than 50,000 people






